has had a revolutionary impact on the deciphering of ancient Egyptian hieroglyphs The ability to understand hieroglyphs has uncovered much of the history, customs and culture of Egypt's ancient past It is these ancient hieroglyphs that tell the tales of the otherwise long forgotten Pharaohs

The Evolution of Egyptian Hieroglyphs

For many years, no one knew how to read hieroglyphs anymore Then, in 1799, the Rosetta Stone was discovered On this stone, a speech by the Egyptian king Ptolemy V from 196 BC had been written down The same text was written in three languages, once in Greek, once in hieroglyphics and once in another Egyptian script called demotic Demotic
